<b>Demographics</b>	Must be a Lancaster County Resident and 18 years or older	Must be a Lancaster County Resident and 18 years or older	Must be a Lancaster County Resident and current or former member of any branch of the military, including the Reserves and National Guard

<b>Offense Nexus</b>	Conduct giving rise to the crime must be attributable to characteristics of the defendant's substance use disorder	Conduct giving rise to the crime must be attributable to characteristics of the defendant's mental illness	No nexus required
<b>Diagnostic Criteria</b>	Must have a verifiable history of substance abuse.	Must have one of the following diagnoses: -Schizophrenia -Major Mood Disorder (Bipolar Disorder, Major Depression) -Psychotic Disorder (Schizoaffective Disorder) -Borderline Personality Disorder	PTSD (Post-Traumatic Stress Disorder) TBI (Traumatic Brain Injury) MST (Military Sexual Trauma) Drug/Alcohol Addiction Other Axis I diagnoses that include but are not limited to: Major Depression, Bipolar Disorder, Schizophrenia, Schizoaffective Disorder
<b>Exclusionary/ Non-Exclusionary Factors</b>	Mental illness is <b>not an exclusionary</b> factor <b>unless</b> it precludes an individual's ability to participate in the Drug Court program	<b>Exclusionary:</b> Organic Brain Injury, Intellectual disability, Dementia or Alzheimer's <b>NOT Exclusionary:</b> Co-occurring Substance Abuse Disorder	Cannot be dishonorably discharged from the military
<b>Benefits/Tracks</b>	<b>Diversiónary:</b> charges may be dismissed, and record expunged <b>Modified:</b> Defendant pleads guilty to a minimum of two specific offenses, one more serious than the other. Upon successful completion of the Drug Court program, the more serious charge will be dismissed <b>Post-Sentence:</b> reduction or termination of any remaining supervision	<b>Diversiónary:</b> charges may be dismissed, and record expunged <b>Modified:</b> Defendant pleads guilty to a minimum of two specific offenses, one more serious than the other.
