Diversion	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Enter guilty plea to all charges.</li> <li>2. Sentencing is deferred.</li> <li>3. Drug Court conditions imposed.</li> </ol>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Successful completion of four phases and aftercare results in dismissal of all charges.</li> <li>2. Dismissed charges eligible for record expungement with consent of District Attorney and approval of the Court.</li> </ol>
Modified	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Enter guilty plea to all charges. Minimum of two offenses, with once more serious than the other.</li> <li>2. Sentencing is deferred.</li> <li>3. Drug Court conditions imposed.</li> </ol>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Successful completion of four phases and aftercare results in dismissal or reduction of more serious charge.</li> <li>2. Will result in a conviction of the lesser offense. Supervision on the lesser offense subject to termination.</li> </ol>
Non-Diversion	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Enter guilty plea to all charges.</li> <li>2. Sentenced by Drug Court Judge on all charges.</li> <li>3. Successful completion of Drug Court and aftercare imposed as a condition of supervision.</li> </ol>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Sentencing considerations.</li> <li>2. Successful completion of four phases and aftercare results in reduction or termination of any remaining supervision.</li> <li>3. Will result in a conviction of all offenses; record may not be expunged</li> </ol>
Probation/Parole Violation	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Stipulate to Violation.</li> <li>2. Resentenced to a period of supervision of at least 2 years.</li> <li>3. Successful completion of Drug Court and aftercare imposed as a condition of supervision.</li> </ol>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Sentencing/resentencing considerations.</li> <li>2. Successful completion of four phases and aftercare results in reduction or termination of any remaining supervision.</li> </ol>
